5 Days Fast & Pray (5-9 July)



To encourage all our churches to fast & pray in unity for a move of God to revive us and our churches.

SAT 5 JULY

Day 1: Fix Our Eyes on Jesus

Objective: Coming back to fixing our eyes on Jesus, rather than allowing the things of the world to be our foundation in life

Hebrews 12:2 - "Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith."

Reflection: Amid life's challenges, where do you fix your gaze? Do you first look to Jesus or do you find yourself turning to the things of this world for support and comfort? Let's take some time to ask God to realign our hearts, helping us to fix our eyes on Him.

Prayer:

- In every situation, we would fix our eyes on Jesus, the source of our hope and strength.
- We would trust in Him more, turning to Him rather than the things of this world.

Conference Prayer Point:

Pray for journey mercy for all those travelling to OC: The speakers and attendees.

SUN 6 JULY

Day 2: Set Our Hearts and Minds Above

Objective: Intentionally realign our hearts and minds back to God. To begin to think about whether we have lost sight of living our life in view of eternity.

Colossians 3:2 - "Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things."

Psalm 19:14 - "May these words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer."

Reflection: Where do you find your heart and mind wandering to? What propels you forward in life? Is your heart set on eternity? Life's distractions can often pull us away from having an eternal focus. Today, consider where your heart and mind dwell. Are you rooted in things that are fleeting or anchored in the eternity?

Prayer:

- Holy Spirit would reveal where our hearts and minds have been set on worldly things.
- God would help us in lifting our hearts and minds heavenward and building a desire to live a life pleasing to Him.

Conference Prayer Point:

We would have soft hearts to receive what God will speak to us during the conference.

MON 7 JULY

Day 3: Our Citizenship in Heaven

Objective: Be reminded that we have a life to live beyond our time on Earth. We are heading for eternity!

Hebrews 11:13-16 - "All these people were still living by faith when they died... they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them."

Philippians 3:20 - "But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Saviour from there, the Lord Jesus Christ."

Reflection: As the children of God, we are citizens of heaven, merely passing through this world. Our time here is limited! How does this truth shape your daily choices?

Prayer:

- We would be reminded that we are citizens of heaven headed for eternity!
- God would help us to run the race faithfully until He calls us home.

Conference Prayer Point:

- Anointing to be on all the speakers and everyone serving in the conference.

TUES 8 JULY

Day 4: Storing Treasure in Heaven

Objective: Reflect on what we have been holding onto as treasure. Hear from God what He is calling us into in this season

Matthew 6:20 - "But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy."

Reflection: Earthly treasures fade, but heavenly investments last forever. How are you investing in eternal things today? Are you walking in what God has called you to, storing up treasure in heaven?

Prayer:

- We will value the things that matter in light of eternity.
- We would have the grace to let go of the treasures of this world.
- We would boldly step into what God is calling us to in this season.

Conference Prayer Point:

Pray there would be breakthroughs, both personally and corporately.

WED 9 JULY

Day 5: The Hope of Eternal Glory

Objective: We would have a renewed sense of hope for what is to come from realigning our perspective to an eternal one.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 - "For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."

Reflection: With the realities of life, it can be tempting to become weighed down and lose our hope for what is to come, eternal glory. How is your hope level at the moment? Invite God to increase your hope for what is ahead. We are headed for eternity with Him!

Prayer:

- God would continue to fill our hearts with the hope for the eternal glory ahead of us.

- A lifting of any heaviness that people may be experiencing in this season.

Conference Prayer Point:

Pray that we would encounter open heavens in each of the sessions.
